

# 2020 Tiburon Pool Handbook

## Introduction

The Tiburon Pool Board and Staff welcome you to a summer of swimming and fun at Tiburon Swim Pool. The swim season is from Saturday, May 23rd thru Monday September 7<sup>th</sup>. This handbook includes operational information on the pool, swim lessons, swim team, swim parties and your responsibilities as a member. Let's have a fun and safe summer!

## Membership

As a member of the Tiburon Swimming Pool it is your responsibility to become familiar with and follow the Pool Admittance Procedures and Swimming Pool Rules in this Handbook.

***Please review these procedures and rules with your family.***

The Board has instituted a policy that would revoke the membership of any member who brings a guest without signing them in and paying the guest fee. There will be no exceptions to the enforcement of this policy. Members may only have five (5) guests per day.

## Pool Admittance

Membership cards will be held at the pool. Your card will be pulled each day when you sign in. You must also register and pay for any guests at this time. The daily guest fees are:

Children 12 months & under	Free
Children 12 and under	\$3.00
Adults (13+)	\$5.00

### Non-refundable Punch Pass

10-Punch Pass – Child	\$25.00
10-Punch Pass – Adult	\$45.00

Guests' must be accompanied by a member for admittance to the pool. They will not be admitted without a member present to sign them in.

## Pool Hours

Weekdays	12:00 – 5:00 6:00 – 8:30*
Weekends	12:00 – 8:30

**\*Note: The pool will be closed EVERY WEDNESDAY EVENING for scheduled swim team meets and private pool parties.**

## Weather Related Closures

The pool will not open during thunderstorms or when the outside temperature is below 70 degrees. The pool manager uses the weather service report at 342-8463 to make this decision.

## Flotation Devices

No flotation devices (inner tubes, air mattresses, **water wings**) will be permitted in the pool. Water wings have been determined by the Red Cross to be the most dangerous personal flotation device used by swimmers. Children 5 years and under **accompanied by an adult in the water** may wear U.S. Coast Guard approved lifejackets.

## Snack Area

Outside food and drink are permitted; however, food (including candy) should be eaten **only in the designated snack area**. This helps to keep the deck clean and reduce the likelihood of trash blowing into the pool and attracts fewer birds and bugs.

## Pool Parties

Pool party requests will not be honored until the pool opens for the summer. They may be handled with a manager at the pool office during hours of operation. You must be a pool member to have a pool party. Rates for pool parties are:

Up to 50 people	\$200
Up to 100 people	\$225
Up to 200 people	\$250

The party will not be reserved until full fee is paid. No exceptions.

## Swim Team

Swim team is open to swimmers between the ages of 6 and 18. Applications can be downloaded from our website and be returned by mail or dropped off at the pool. The deadline for swim team registration is May 31st. Swim team fees are \$80 for the first swimmer in a family and \$60 for each additional swimmer. This includes a team t-shirt for each swimmer.

**The first practice is scheduled for Tuesday, May 28th, and there will be a parent meeting, May 31st at 5:30 p.m.** Practices are held Monday thru Friday, 8-9a.m. for 11-18 year olds, and 9-10a.m. for 10 and under. Make-up practices are held in the evenings from 5-6, Monday thru Thursday. Swim meets are Wednesday evenings.

## Swim Lessons

Swim lesson registration will be held at the pool on Saturday, May 11th from 10 to 12 pm. The cost is \$30 per child per class. The cost of \$40 will be charged for those failing to pre-register by May 23rd. No one will be allowed to start lessons if they have not paid. There must be at least 4 children registered for a class to be held. Swim lessons are Red Cross Certified, information about levels and skills will be available at swim lesson registration.

## Swimming Pool Rules & Regulations

These rules are for the protection and benefit of all members of the Tiburon Pool and their guests. Parents should communicate these rules to their children. The pool manager or assistant managers have the authority to suspend any member/guest of the Tiburon Pool for a period of 1 to 10 days for violation of these rules. The pool manager shall have the authority to resolve all disputes arising from the interpretation and application of these rules. Flagrant violations could lead to cancellation of membership by the Tiburon Pool Board.

1. At the direction of the lifeguards on duty, all swimmers will immediately leave the pool.
2. Running, pushing, rowdiness, or profanity is strictly forbidden, including in the bathhouse. **Any activity that endangers the patrons, staff or the pool is prohibited.**
3. Playing or hanging on railings, steps, ropes, fence, gates, or ladders is prohibited.
4. **Persons under the influence of alcohol will not be admitted. No intoxicants may be brought onto the grounds.**
5. Children under the age of 12 must be supervised by parents or another designated caregiver.
6. Only one person is permitted on the diving board at a time. No diving except in the diving area.
7. Adults only swimming during the 10 minute rest break (18 & older).
8. The use of the baby pool is restricted to children 6 years and under. All children at the baby pool must be accompanied by a responsible individual 18 years or older. Nebraska health regulations require that all untrained children wear swim diapers.
9. Admission may be refused for anyone with skin abrasions, inflamed eyes, skin rashes, 1 inch or larger bandages, infectious diseases, etc.
10. Tiburon Pool is a smoke free environment.
11. Glass is not allowed in the pool area.
12. **No pets** allowed inside the pool area.
13. All bathers must shower before entering the pool.
14. Swim suits only.
15. The Tiburon Swimming Pool will not be responsible for any accident of injury in connection with the use of the pool and other facilities. Members and their guests swim at their own risk.
16. The Tiburon Swimming Pool will not be responsible for the loss or damage to personal property.

Any issues with regard to the rules and regulations shall be presented to the Tiburon Pool Board in writing.
